GRADE SIX BAND
RULES – PROCEDURES – GRADING

Attendance

Members of the band are expected to be in their assigned seat, ready to play two minutes after the beginning class bell rings. Students are to hold all questions until everyone is seated. This expedites the rehearsal process for all involved. Extra rehearsals are sometimes scheduled during the school year. These rehearsals and sectionals will follow the same time schedule.

Band members are required to be present at all performances during the school year. *****Failure to attend any performance, without an approved excused absence by the director, will result in a 25 point deduction for that particular marking period after all grade calculations are made. The points cannot be made up after the fact.***** (See the concert schedule at the end of these rules/regulations).

****Please keep in mind that being in a performing ensemble is a team based activity and is a commitment. We are all counting on each other. As a member of the band we need you to make EVERY EFFORT to attend all performances and rehearsals.****

REHEARSAL PROCEDURES

- Promptness: Be on time.
- All questions are held until all are seated and the director is on the podium. Failure to follow this rule will result in a 5 point deduction at the end of the semester.
- Self-discipline: No talking when the director is on the podium.
- Rehearsal schedule: Arrange music in the same order you see listed on the board each day.
- Be neat: pick up around you. Do not move equipment from section to section. Replace chairs and stands to their original locations.
- Each student is responsible for having their own pencil at their stand and use it to write down specific changes as we make them. Failure to have a pencil will result in a five point deduction at the end of the semester.
- Gum and food are not allowed in the band room. Failure to follow this rule will result in a 5 point deduction at the end of the semester.

NO BAND IS BETTER THAN ITS REHEARSAL. REHEARSE AS IF IT WERE A CONCERT!

INSTRUMENTS

- All instruments cases and drum sticks must clearly have names posted on them.
- Students are to write their instrument's serial number on the signature page of this document.
- Drummers: any personally lost stick is your responsibility to replace. All sticks without names are considered to be the property of the MBA Middle School Band. Drummers are to stand during rehearsal. Chairs are not to be allowed in the percussion section. Failure to follow this rule will result in a 5 point deduction at the end of the semester.

· School owned instruments must be signed out with the director. Damaged equipment will be repaired at your expense.

MUSIC

Each band member is responsible for their music folder and the condition of its content, making sure it is in school daily for rehearsals.

Students will receive new music from the band secretary or Mrs. Wolf. If a second copy is needed, it is to be obtained through the band secretary. Please keep in mind that sheet music is expensive to replace, and treat your copies carefully.

INSTRUMENT STORAGE

· Every member will receive a locker in the band room for daytime storage only. You are responsible for the condition of the locker and its content. Do not mix your instruments with the 7th and 8th graders.

· Instruments and music are to go home every evening for practice.

· Students should bring their instruments to the band room before morning homeroom. As soon as you drop it off you are to report to homeroom. The music wing is not a place to loiter in. It is your responsibility to be in homeroom on time. Instrument drop-off is never an excuse for tardiness.

CONCERT DRESS

Every member is responsible to own a pair of BLACK pants, BLACK, shoes, BLACK socks and a BLACK turtleneck shirt. Absolutely no substitution of color is acceptable. (If finances limit your ability to purchase these items, contact Mrs. Wolf and she will make arrangements for purchase on a confidential basis.)

The Somers Music Patrons supply band shirts at cost (\$15 ea). We keep an inventory. What you purchase, you own. You will be fitted for a shirt prior to the first concert. **ALL BAND SHIRT MONEY (\$15) IS DUE BY SEPTEMBER 12th, 2017.**

GRADING

50% of your grade is based on weekly lesson attendance. The only excused absences are classroom tests/quizzes or illness on the scheduled day of the lesson.

50% of your grade is based on your individual improvement on your assigned instrument.

Students can increase their grades by:

- a. Active Listening Assignments (up to 15 pts. depending on the quality of work)
- b. Attendance at public concerts (5 pts./concert attended. Either a program, with a student and parent signature or an "Attended Concert" Google Form must be submitted before the closing of grades each semester. The concert credit is given during the marking period that the concert date occurred in.)

- c. Practice Journals may be submitted online through Google Forms (5 pts. ea.)
- d. Personal public performances, ie. church, Lions Club, Rotary, recitals, etc. (10 pts. ea.)
- e. Private study or tutoring sessions – must have proper documentation. (30 pts./quarter)
- f. **There will be a 5 point deduction per day for late forms.** This includes uniform and music returns as well as fees collected. 5 pts. will be given when forms and fees meet deadlines.
- g. Students can occasionally earn merits and demerits through in class participation. (5 pts. ea.)

Playing Assessments: Students will be requested to play portions of their music at any point and time throughout the school year, for a grade, without prior warning. This performance may take place with the director, or before the entire band. It is highly suggested that students keep up with their daily practice as to be prepared for this portion of their grade. Students may also be asked to record themselves and submit the recording for a grade.

Cell Phones: Any student using a cell phone during class (including all aspects of the phone: calls, texting and pictures) without explicit permission given by the teacher will receive a full grade deduction at the end of the marking period. Any student with a phone on their person during a performance on stage or performing venue will receive a failing grade for that marking period.

MANDATORY PERFORMANCE DATES:

- **Winter Concert - December 7 at 7:00 pm. (snow Dec. 12)**
- **Daytime Assembly – December 22**
- **Spring Concert – May 17 at 7:00 pm**

In conclusion: I expect all of the above rules and procedures to be followed on a daily basis. When in operation, they will assist us in being of the highest quality possible.

Students failing to adhere to any portion of the above listed regulations will be subject to disciplinary action and/or point deductions. Those students persisting in improper behavior will be removed from the band without hesitation.

Let's make this year the very best! Treat others with respect and work hard, and the rewards will be great!
